Length 40' (39.3' documentation length)

We replaced mast, rigging and *chainplates* in 2006 after we completed The Loop. We used the same folks who do did the rigging for Island Packet. The mast is 41', taller than the original mast.

Tanks

Fuel 200 gallon capacity

Water 200 gallon capacity

Both tanks are fiberglass. Access is aft of cabin at stern.

Head

Forward with separate shower.

New Raritan PHE II toilet with new hose to 10 gal. holding tank

New Jabsco macerator

Counter is granite with SS sink and *new* faucet and hoses.

Three (3) storage cupboards

Shower sump is under sole in head with easy access to sump pump

Forward Berth

Side-loading berth, queen-size on starboard side

Two storage areas underneath in addition two nine (9) deep drawers

One hanging locker at foot of berth with shelf.

Wide two-door hanging locker on port side with shelf above. We converted one side of this to shelving, but can be removed easily.

Galley/Dinette

Starboard side galley

Isotherm refrigerator under the counter next to sink. In addition, there is a deep icebox with drain that we currently use as a dry storage area for supplies

New faucet and hoses

Microwave

Five (5) drawers for utensils, etc, as well as two cupboards for additional items like dishes, condiments.

Port side dinette

Teak table, used also if converting dinette to berth. Original table was not teak, but we changed that at Atlantic Yacht Basin in Virginia.

Three separate storage areas under the settees. (Settees and forward berth were replaced with new foam and fabric in 2002.)
